The Center for Cultural Analysis at Rutgers University, New Brunswick invites applications for **one-month residential fellowships** at the National Humanities Center in Research Triangle Park, North Carolina. Located equidistantly between Durham and Chapel Hill, the NHC is the only independent American institution devoted to advanced research in the Humanities, awarding approximately forty full-year residential fellowships each year to scholars from across the United States and internationally (<http://nationalhumanitiescenter.org>).


This is the first year of the Summer Fellowship Program, which will extend for four weeks, from **June 4-29, 2018**. Fellows will be given a private office overlooking the woods, full use of the NHC's superb library services, breakfasts and lunches Monday-Friday, and local housing. Fellows are responsible for their own transportation to and from North Carolina and while at the Center. Applications from tenured and tenure-track faculty at any rank and in any Humanities field at the Rutgers, New Brunswick, Newark, or Camden campuses will be considered, with preference given to faculty working on extended (book-length) research projects. Applications must be sponsored by the CCA. Costs for the fellowship (\$6500, inclusive) will be borne by individual faculty members, in coordination with their sponsoring institution, on a case-by-case basis. Faculty who wish to apply should begin seeking support directly from their home departments and their campus Humanities Dean as soon as possible.

Faculty members who wish to apply for a Summer Fellowship should submit a 1,000-word project proposal, a short bibliography, and a curriculum vitae, as well as a brief letter of endorsement from their Chair agreeing to a measure of support, by **November 27, 2018 at 5:00 PM** to admin@cca.rutgers.edu. All applications will be reviewed at the CCA by a committee of Humanities faculty; sponsored applications will be forwarded to the NHC, which will make final decisions on awards.
