Tell has served as the Chair of the visual arts committee and a founding member of the board of directors for the West Windsor Arts Council, providing leadership and expertise in the visual arts for this new community arts non-profit.

She received her BFA from the University of Massachusetts and her MFA from the San Francisco Art Institute. Tell makes conceptually driven work in a variety of media on topics of identity, DNA, and personal and cultural history. Her work has been exhibited in the U.S. and Mexico, garnering reviews and grant awards.
